Contributions to Science:

Over the past two decades, my research has primarily focused on the development and evaluation of psychosocial interventions for individuals with schizophrenia and other serious mental illnesses (SMI). I have conducted randomized controlled trials, coauthored three books, and published over 230 papers in peer-reviewed journals, which have been cited 12,000 times. Contributions to science include 1) Development and study of "Narrative Enhancement and Cognitive Therapy" (NECT), an intervention for reducing self-stigma, with Phil Yanos and Paul Lysaker. The intervention was translated and implemented in seven languages and countries). 2) Adaptation and modification of evidence-based practices to Israel's diverse cultures and settings, including Illness Management and Recovery (IMR), Family psyhoeducation and Social Cognition Interactive Therapy (SCIT) and 3) Research and development of methods for collecting and using Patient Reported Outcome Measures (PROMs) and Patient Reported Experience Measures (PREMs) 4) Serving as Associate Editor of the Psychiatric Rehabilitation Journal, Journal of Mental Health, BMC psychiatry, Israel Journal of Psychiatry, and a member of the editorial board of Psychiatry Research, Journal of Clinical Psychology, Psychiatry Research Communications, Stigma and Health, Psychosis, American Journal of Psychiatric Rehabilitation and Social Welfare (Hebrew).
